Joan did not make most of her money in comedy. She made her fortune by selling clothing, jewelry and fashion accessories for the QVC shopping network. She worked very hard for QVC for nearly 24 years and sold a lot merchandise for them. Her TV production company and cable program also kept her in the public eye.

Both Elizabeth Taylor and Joan Rivers paid attention to the details of financial and estate planning. Their money will go to the people and causes they cared about.
